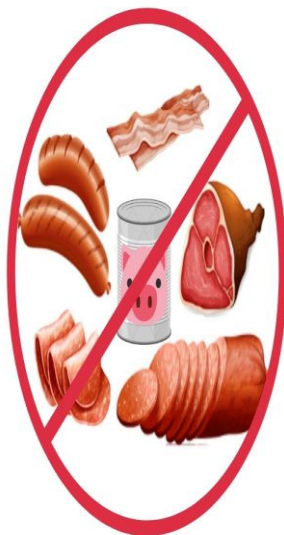

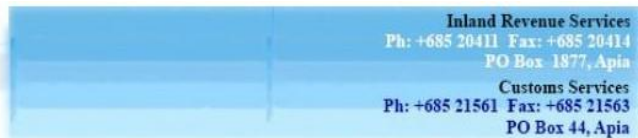
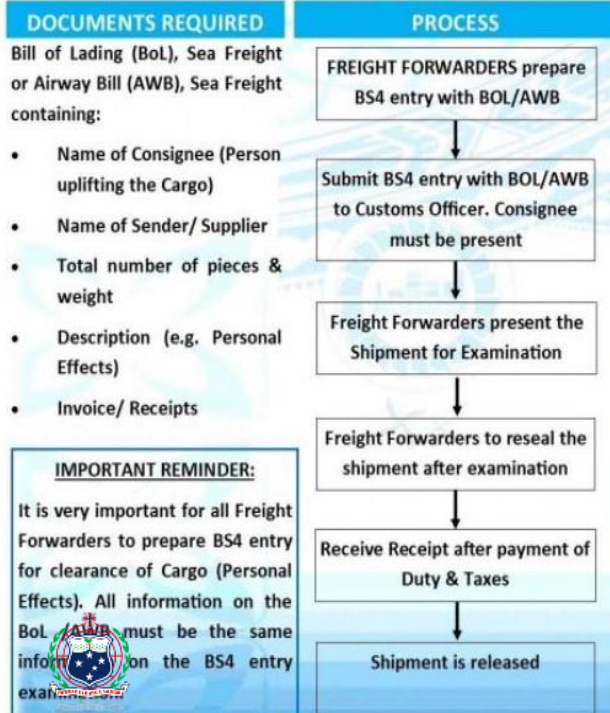

- ☒ **Climate change** - how will your development respond to the effects of climate change e.g. increased flooding and cyclones?
- ☒ **Landscaping** - use of native landscaping to minimise hard surfaces and enhance visual amenity.
- ☒ **Built character** - do the heights and shapes of proposed buildings complement adjacent buildings?
- ☒ **Traffic, parking and access** - is there sufficient vehicular access and parking spaces provided with no impediments to traffic movement?
- ☒ **Site utilities** - connectivity to electricity, sewer, water, telecommunications and drainage systems.
- ☒ **PUMA planning policies** - does the development comply with relevant plans and policies, e.g. Parking Policy and Standards 2006, Signage Policy 2016, Noise Policy 2011, Housing Guideline 2006, Coastal Infrastructure Management Plans and others.

WHAT IS A PESTICIDE?

A substance or mixture of substance which:

- Is used for preventing, destroying, or controlling any pest, or
- May be administered to animals for the control of insects, arachnids or other pests in/on their bodies

Guidelines to Register Pesticides?

1. Submit complete application form to the Registrar of Pesticides
2. Submission and discussion of the pesticide application to the Pesticide Technical Committee for approval
3. Pesticide Technical Committee determine whether the application can be Registered, on Hold or Refused

4. Approval of the application to be Registered
5. A 5 years validity certificate of Pesticides is issued
6. A permit to import must be obtained which is annually renewed

WHY MUST YOU REGISTER A PESTICIDE?

Any form of pesticide must be registered to ensure that it complies with the relevant conditions in respect of the import, manufacture, packing, labelling, storage, sale, distribution, advertising, application, possession or safe use of the pesticide

ENTERING SAMOA

It is important that you help us Protect Samoa from Pests and Diseases. You must Declare or Dispose of any Risk Items at the Port of Entry. You might have goods with you that could be carrying pests and diseases. Samoa being vulnerable to changes, these pests and diseases could cause havoc to our country's environment and economy, Thus creating stress to the livelihoods of our people and children.

FOLLOW THESE 3 SIMPLE STEPS

1. Complete and honestly fill out your Passenger Arrival Card. Declare any risk goods
2. Dispose of any risk goods or agricultural items that you have not declared, in the Biosecurity Amnesty Bins
3. Present your Passenger Arrival Card to our Quarantine staff. Declared risk goods may then be inspected. Your bags may be sniffed by detector dogs, x-rayed or searched

WHAT HAPPENS TO DECLARED GOODS

After inspection, our biosecurity officers would return your declared goods if they are safe or have met Quarantine requirements. However, some goods may require treatment. Any prohibited items will be destroyed.

RISK GOODS YOU MUST DECLARE

All of these goods are a risk to Samoa and must be declared. If you are not sure, declare.
